

Fund Raisers Report for the year 2006 The Bishop's Trust for St. Thomas's

Events held Attic sale Town Hall 4.2.06, made over £1000: small Bric a Brac sale in church grounds 11.6.06, made approx. £250; charity day at the Cricket Club 2.7.06, made approx. £500; Heritage Open Days teas at Mostyn House and St. Thomas's church open 9/10th Sept. 06, teas made approx. £350 and many donations were received at the church.

Other fund raisers Cards were produced suitable for Christmas. The snow scenes were taken on 12th March 06 ! There are three card designs. A total for a thousand of each design with envelopes were printed. £1023 has been taken by mid-Jan 07, with about cards still available for sale (Anne 336 6146 or Yvonne 336 4369). Two donations have been received, £25 and £50 as a result of the cards.

Other items the autumn months after the heritage weekend was spent doing the major grant application to the Big Lottery.

During the summer and autumn a series of Business Plan meetings were held, the results of which were used in the grant application.
